### WHAT IS THE SUMMER CAREER EXPLORATION PROGRAM?

HireAbility Vermont works to provide high school youth with disabilities with summer work experience and training that will facilitate success in life after school. The goal is to connect youth with an exciting summer career opportunity based on their interests, strengths and skills—all meant to create a meaningful experience for both youth and employers.

### PROGRAM DETAILS:

- Employees are high school students 14-21 years old
- Program is 3 to 8 weeks during the summer months of June-August
- Each week students work 10-32 hours
- Students earn minimum wage (HireAbility Vermont manages payroll)
- 2 hours (or more) of job skills class time included in each work week
